

## LENORA LEGGATT, VIOLIN



Violinist Lenora Cox Leggatt served as concertmaster for Cleveland Opera for ten years, and for the Ohio Chamber Orchestra and Cleveland San Jose Ballet. She has performed and toured with the Cleveland Orchestra, and has enjoyed playing with the San Diego Symphony as a primary substitute since 2007. Originally from Rochester, New York, she began studying at age 7 and made her solo debut with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra at age 16. Ms. Leggatt earned a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music studying with Catherine Tait and Zvi Zeitlin, and a Master of Music degree from the Cleveland Institute of Music with Donald Weilerstein. A three-year fellowship student at Aspen Music Festival, she has also performed in Tanglewood, Basel and London where she

gave a world premiere performance with her twin sister, oboist Johanna Cox. Lenora has appeared as concertmaster under conductors such as Leonard Slatkin and Andre Previn, and as soloist under Peter Bay and Leslie Dunner.
